

# **CYO Tennis Tiebreaker Rules**

(revised 9/30/08)

## ***FOR WIMBLEDON I THROUGH DAVIS CUP MATCHES:***

### ***“The 9-Point Tiebreaker”***

**When a set reaches 6 games to 6, many times a “tiebreaker” is used. A “tiebreaker” can be any agreed upon number of points won first. The NVJCYO Tennis League uses the 5 out of 9 points “tiebreaker” for all divisions, as it is the most common in non-tournament play.**

**Serving must remain in the same order as used throughout the match. Each server serves 2 points each. The individual or team that wins 5 points first, wins. Change sides after 4 points are played. In the event of 4 points to 4 points tie, the last server serves the final point. Opposing team or player can decide the court side to be served. Home court rules take precedence at all times.**
