In the case of uneven team sizes, "Every attempt must be made to match players of like ability." (See rule #2 in "Section 2 Team Structure"). See sheet titled, "Varying Team Sizes" to determine the # of singles and doubles matches required. A player's position on the team ladder is best determined by challenge matches during the week. At no time should players be moved around in order for the team to gain an advantage (Rules, Section 2:2). When one team has more players than the other, the smaller team is to make every effort to play a player of like ability against a player of the larger team. This generally means that the #s 1 and 2 will not play a second match, as they would be playing a player placed much lower on the ladder. The coach of a smaller team should make sure the players of like ability remain at the match site to play the lower placed players of the larger team. (Rule 4:2)

All games played will have no-Ads. Player/Team that wins a point on a 40-40 scores, wins the game. A **9-point tie breaker point system** will be used for ALL divisions except Davis Cup. Teams will change sides after playing 4 points. **The team to first score 5 points wins the match.** In case of tied sets won by both team, a **doubles tie breaker** should be played to determine the match winner. The match game scores will then be 7 games to 6.

Both coaches should sign and *keep* a copy of the score sheets. Both coaches should email scores to assigned Division Results Coordinator with a carbon copy sent to the League Commissioner (Mimi Sullivan) at TennisCommissioner@nvjcyo.org no later 5:00 pm Monday, after match. **The following information should be specified in the email subject : Division, Date, Location and the Total lines for both the Home and Visitor above (*).**
